Overall record:	0-0	1-0	1-0	<p><b>PIPPINS SPOIL RAPTORS INAUGURAL GAME:</b> The Pippins rolled into the Ridgefield Outdoor Recreation Complex and spoiled the inaugural game in Ridgefield Raptors history on Tuesday, pulling out with a 4-3 win. Dylan Barkley was strong for the Pippins on the bump, tossing a quality start after allowing 3 runs (2 earned) over 6-plus innings. A 3-run 5th inning capped off by a Zach Lew RBI double pushed the Pippins ahead, and Daniel Cipriano's go-ahead double down the line in the 8th put Yakima Valley ahead for good. Joe Magrisi was up to 94 MPH with his fastball in a 1-2-3 ninth inning, striking out the side and saving the first game of the year.</p> <p><b>NOT-SO-FREE PASSES:</b> The Pippins pitching staff - Barkley, Magrisi, and reliever Mark Woinarowicz, did not issue a walk on Opening Night, making it the first time since August 7th, 2018 against the Corvallis Knights that Pippins pitchers did not surrender a free pass. The trio of Yakima Valley arms also combined for 12 strikeouts (Barkley, 6; Magrisi, 3; Woinarowicz, 3). The 12 strikeouts was the most for Pippins pitching since they struck out 12 on July 31st, 2018 against Victoria.</p> <p><b>FOR THE PIPPINS:</b> Right-hander Scott Youngbrandt makes his first start of the season for the Pippins on Wednesday. The Tinley Park, IL, native pitched in 3 games for Saint Louis University this past spring, pitching just 2.2 innings, but posting a 1-1 record and 13.50 ERA. Youngbrandt pitched one scoreless inning in Sunday's exhibition game against the Seattle Studs, striking out one. A two-way player, he has also appeared in games in right field and as the Pippins' designated hitter so far this year.</p> <p><b>FOR THE RAPTORS:</b> Ridgefield has not announced a projected starting pitcher for tonight's game.</p> <p><b>LOOKING FOR 2-0:</b> The Pippins will look to start the season 2-0 today, something they have not accomplished since sweeping Wenatchee to open up the 2016 season. That series was one of two season-opening sweeps in team history, with the other coming in 2015 against Klamath Falls.</p> <p><b>BULLPEN LOCKS IN:</b> The Pippins never led by more than 2 runs on Tuesday, but the bullpen duo of Woinarowicz and Magrisi kept things in check. The duo faced 10 batters out of the bullpen, allowing just 1 single. Other than the single, only one other ball left the infield - a 7th inning flyout by Jonny Weaver. The pair struck out 6 of 9 batters retired, and threw a combined 27 of their 39 pitches for strikes (69.2%).</p>
